Credit Financier Invest Limited ("CFI UK", "we", "us" or "our") is a company registered in England and Wales (Company Number 11634673), authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority (FRN 828955), with registered office at 16 Berkeley Street, London, W1J 8DZ.

This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, which cookies we use on our website at <https://cfi.trade> (the "Website"), why we use them, and how you can control them. It should be read alongside our Privacy Notice, which is available on the Website.

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work, to work more efficiently, and to provide information to website operators. Cookies are not harmful to your device.

Cookies may be:

- Session cookies — temporary cookies that expire when you close your browser.
- Persistent cookies — cookies that remain on your device for a defined period or until you delete them.
- First-party cookies — set directly by CFI UK.
- Third-party cookies — set by a third-party domain, such as an analytics or advertising provider.

The use of cookies in the UK is governed by the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 (as amended) ("PECR"), read alongside the UK General Data Protection Regulation ("UK GDPR") and the Data Protection Act 2018.

Under Regulation 6 of PECR, we may only store cookies on your device, or access information stored on your device, if:

- the cookie is strictly necessary to provide a service you have explicitly requested; or
- you have given your prior, informed, freely given and unambiguous consent.

The consent standard under PECR is the same as under UK GDPR Article 4(11): consent must be a freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of your wishes, expressed by a clear positive act. Consent cannot be implied from continued use of the Website, pre-ticked boxes, or inactivity.

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before withdrawal. See Section 6 for how to manage your preferences.

We use the categories of cookies set out below. Where consent is required, we will ask for it via our cookie consent banner before placing any non-essential cookies on your device. The details of the cookies collected is present on the CFI UK website.

4.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the Website to function and are set in response to actions you take, such as logging in or using security features. No consent is required for strictly necessary cookies under Regulation 6(4) of PECR.

4.2 Functional Cookies

These cookies allow the Website to remember your choices and provide enhanced functionality. If you do not allow them, some features may not function as intended. Your consent is required before these cookies are placed.

4.3 Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the Website by collecting and reporting information. This enables us to improve the Website's performance. Your consent is required before these cookies are placed.

4.4 Marketing and Targeting Cookies



Marketing cookies may be used to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant advertising on the Website or on other platforms. Your consent is required before these cookies are placed. If you do not consent, you will not receive targeted advertising based on your browsing behaviour.

When you first visit the Website, you will be presented with a cookie consent banner. This banner allows you to accept all non-essential cookies, reject all non-essential cookies, or set granular preferences by cookie category. We will not place any non-essential cookies on your device until you have made a positive, active choice.

Continuing to browse the Website without interacting with the banner does not constitute consent. Your preferences will be recorded with a timestamp and stored to allow us to demonstrate compliance with PECR. You may update or withdraw your consent at any time via our cookie preference centre (see Section 6).

6.1 Our Cookie Preference Centre

You can review and update your cookie preferences at any time by visiting our cookie preference centre [insert link]. This allows you to withdraw or amend consent for individual cookie categories without affecting strictly necessary cookies.

6.2 Browser Settings

Most browsers allow you to manage cookies through their settings, including viewing, blocking or deleting cookies. Please note that blocking strictly necessary cookies may prevent you from logging in to your trading account or using certain Website features.
